DETAILS	<p>1. Amid ongoing security situation (Gulf of Oman/Arabian Gulf), reports of increased electronic interference in the region have emerged. Pakistani Flagged carrier MT SIBI, currently anchored in Dubai anchorage, has reported experiencing persistent GPS interference, with a garbled screen display rendering GPS data unusable. Similar interference has also been reported by other vessels transiting through area. This development is in continuation of GPS anomalies highlighted in the advisory issued on 17 Jun 25 (Info Alert No 188/25), wherein MT SHALAMAR was erroneously shown on land (Ras Tanura) since 16 Jun 25 likely due to GPS spoofing/interference.</p> <p>2. This follows a pattern of electronic interference in the region. All vessels are advised to maintain heightened vigilance, use manual and backup navigation systems, and monitor advisories. Any electronic interference/ GPS anomalies should be promptly reported to relevant maritime authorities.</p> <p>3. Forwarded for information, please.</p>
